Dear Junior Tour Members and Parents:

Thank you very much for your interest in participating on the Lake Michigan Junior Golf Tour. We look forward to a great season and wish you much success on the 2011 Junior Tour.

Below is a two part form that must be completed by the junior golfer and a parent or guardian. We have had very few behavior or speed of play complaints from golf course personnel and fellow tour players in the past. In order to maintain our tour's good reputation, we will continue to enforce a strict policy on etiquette, good sportsmanship, and speed of play. Tour members and parents must complete and sign the Code of Conduct before a junior may compete on the tour. Juniors in violation of the Code of Conduct may be subject to disqualification or may not be allowed to compete in future events. **PROFANITY WILL NOT BE TOLERATED AND JUNIORS WHO VIOLATE THIS POLICY MAY BE DISQUALIFIED AT ANY TIME DURING OR AFTER THE ROUND.**

Juniors will be required to complete each nine hole in 2 hours 15 minutes or less. Lead groups will have to play in 2 hours. If the tour representatives or on course rangers determine that a group is out of position or off the speed of play pace, a player or players may be asked to skip a hole to catch up and their score will not count.
